**Parental approval must be obtained before any non-licensed student takes part in shooting activity**

# 2009 ELEY CHALLENGE / TSNZ

## Rules

### Secondary School Postal Shooting Competition

1. Grades : **Boys, Girls, Mixed or Rest** (*Please state clearly which grade you wish to enter*)
2. All shooters must be **full time Students** of the participating school
3. A **TEAM** consists of **three (3) members**.
4. An entry fee of **\$15 per TEAM** is payable and must be sent with the entry form.
5. **Sponsored Ammunition** (50 rounds per shooter) will be supplied to shooters who enter **BY 30<sup>TH</sup> April**
6. **Late Entries** accepted up to **JULY 31** but **NO Sponsored Ammunition** will be supplied.
7. Each shooter must shoot **two (2)** ten shot targets.
8. Targets will be supplied by **TSNZ** on receipt of the official entry form
9. Each shooter may compete in **only one** team.
10. All shooters who choose to shoot off a "**REST**" must enter the "**Rest Grade**"
11. Only shooters who are **not currently affiliated to TSNZ** may shoot off a "**REST**"
12. All shooters **MUST** wear suitable approved hearing protection.
13. Names of shooters need **NOT** be supplied at the time of entry
14. Targets may be **marked** by an affiliated member of **TSNZ OR** returned **unmarked** to the TSNZ Office.
15. Targets, which have been marked by a TSNZ member, **DO NOT** need to be returned to the TSNZ Office, they may be retained by the student.

**RESULTS must be received in the TSNZ Office by 31 AUGUST**
